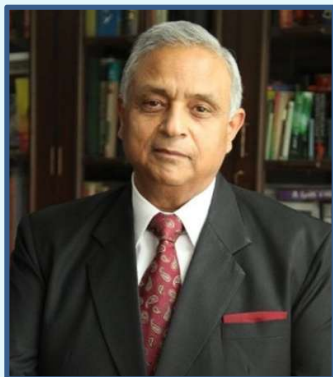

Facilities at DAV Unit VIII

The sprawling campus strikes a balance between modern facilities and natural surroundings, creating an atmosphere that is ideal for students to learn, explore, and grow in perfect harmony with nature. The academic and co-curricular zones are built with state-of-the-art infrastructure and a broad range of provisions.

- **A Career Counselling Cell:** An expert team of certified counselors available during school hours to guide and advise students according to their needs and requirements. Regular counselling sessions are also conducted to maintain their emotional health and well-being.
- **Transport:** A bus/shuttle pick up and drop service is available for all Day Scholars.
- **Wellness Centre:** Medical help is available throughout school hours. The school conducts bi-annual health checks for all students, on campus.

Foundation Stage
